#### **Main Activities and the impact during the past year:**

Junction 24 – during the development of new road infrastructure for the Rail Freight Interchange – traffic management fire-fighting!

In Castle Donington – traffic light phasings negotiated and altered.

Castle Donington Relief Road – developer start date brought forward by 4 weeks and work now commenced.

Helped on public consultation of re-organisation of Children’s Centres (to ensure efficient running).

Working on Kegworth Village centre re-modelling/enhancing pedestrian and parking access with county and district councillors.

#### **Priorities for the immediate future are:**

On completion of Kegworth By-pass - and expected through-village heavy traffic reduction – ensuring that the road (A6) does not become a race-track to the detriment of the village but is pedestrian friendly.

Ensure County Highways support of the above.
