Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

I have campaigned for a Community Speed Watch scheme in Whitwick and I have collected the 200 names required for the scheme to go ahead. The scheme is set to commence in June 2018. I have also been active with street lighting issues in both Whitwick and Thringstone.

Crime has been an issue in the Division, ranging from car crime to ASB. I have been working with the local Police to help resolve residents' concerns.

Pot holes have been a big issue in the Division and I am working with LCC Highways Department to make good and repair potholes.
